SHOULD I INCLUDE PHOTOS?

Yes! Photos that accompany your article are encouraged. Send photos in the following formats:

- **JPEG**
- **TIFF**
- **PNG**

High resolution photos are required for featured images but some lower resolution photos can be used in the body of your article. Cover photos should be at least 780 x 500 pixels. The server will not take photos over 2MB.

If your photo does not have a high enough resolution for our website, we may choose to replace your photo with a stock or custom photo.

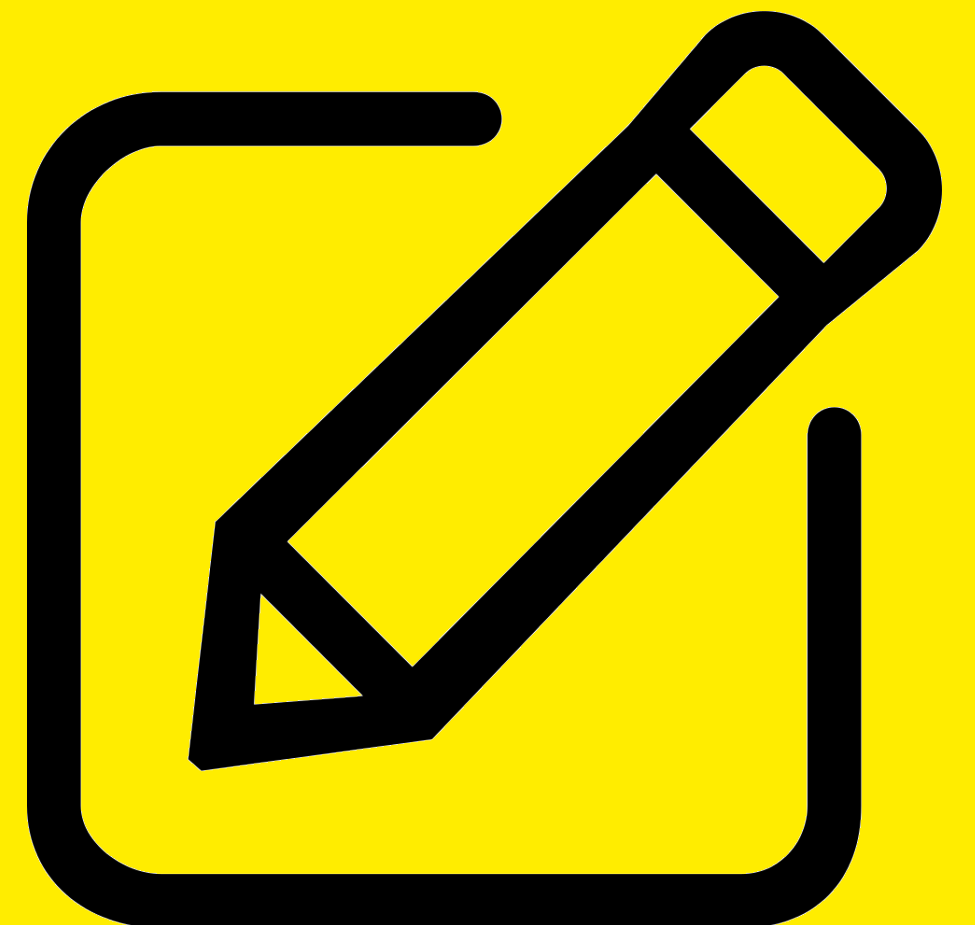
